- Application deadline is September 1.

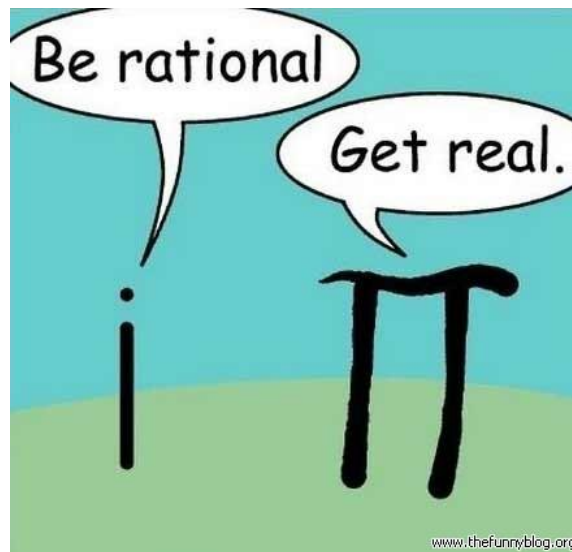
